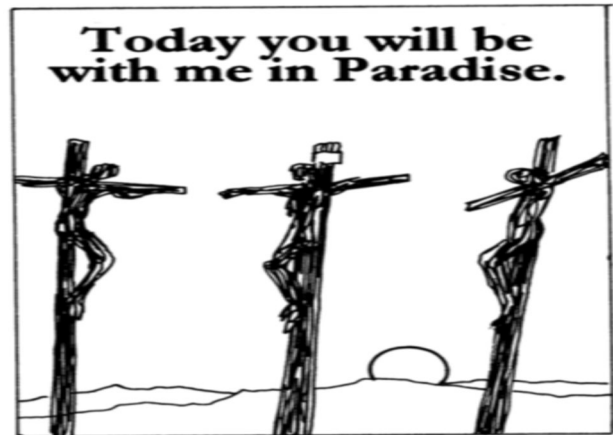

Annual Catholic Appeal

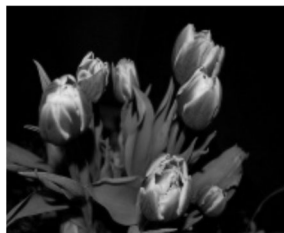
