From the Pastor

It is a pleasure to welcome back the weekly publication of our parish bulletin. It is another indication that we are returning to more normal pastoral life here at St. Bernadette. Be sure to take a copy each week so you can be acquainted with the various aspects of parish life. Continue, as many of you have been, to consult the parish website where information will also be available.

One item of special note is the necessity of returning to Mass and the other sacraments. As you know, our bishop has discontinued the dispensation for watching Mass on TV unless someone is legitimately ill or in other ways medically compromised. This past Sunday there only about 220 people present for all four weekend Masses. Before the pandemic we averaged between 500 and 750 people for all four Masses. Clearly, it is time to come back to church. Fr. Juan and I will continue to encourage people to return, but we cannot do this alone. We need your help. Please do what you can gently and warmly to invite people to return to Mass. When appropriate, without judgement, extend the invitation to come back to God’s house particularly to those who may still be fearful. Recall the instruction of the Letter to the Hebrews, “We should not stay away from our assembly, as is the custom of some, but encourage one another ...” (HEB 10:25)

Enjoy the return of our bulletin and please continue to pray for a complete return to regularly scheduled parish life. God bless you all.
