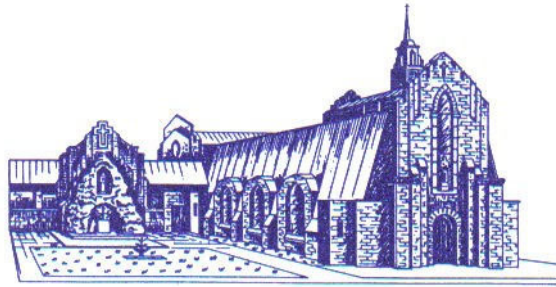
For example, his mother's mother's mother lived in Carini, a city in Sicily near Palermo.
