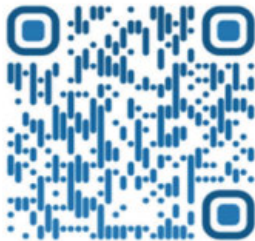

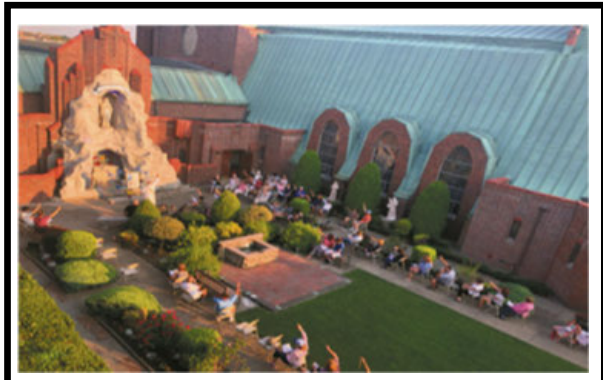
STATIONS OF THE CROSS

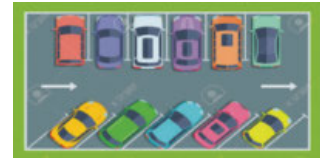

CLOSING CEREMONY AT THE SHRINE CHURCH OF ST. BERNADETTE

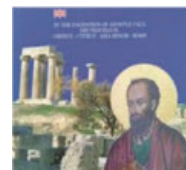
