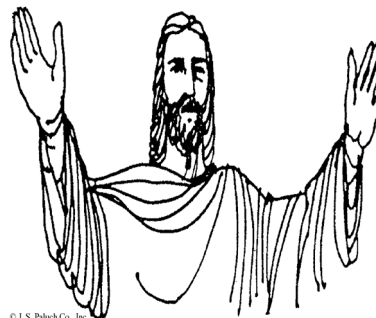
St. Bernadette Girl Scouts Parish Pancake Breakfast

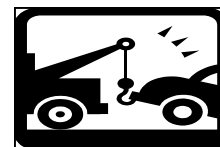
