Fast & Abstinence Regulations for Lent

Catholics from 18-59 years of age are bound by the laws of fast and abstinence. Fast Days (when one full meal and two small meals not equaling the main meal is allowed) are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Days of Abstinence (when eating meat is not permitted) are Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays of Lent, and Good Friday.

On each of the six Thursdays of Lent we will have a Holy Hour of Eucharist Adoration from 7:30 - 8:30 PM. We will have some guest preachers and the theme of the Holy Hours will be The Seven Last Words of Christ.
